Academic Criteria

Lancaster University Management School (LUMS):

- 60% overall Gaokao (incl. 60% Maths)
- 80% on BFSU 2+2 Programme

Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS):

- 60% overall Gaokao (*BA Philosophy, Politics and Economics also requires 60% in Maths*)
- 75% on BFSU 2+2 Programme

English Language Criteria

Course	IELTS	with EAP course (4 Wks)
All of the above	6.5 (min 6.0)	6.0 (min 5.5)

4-Week English for Academic Purposes course (EAP)

Compulsory for all 2+2 students – available to students who have achieved the required IELTS score and for students who require an uplift of 0.5 points to achieve the requirement. The course focuses on English Language, study skills and general orientation. Students are not required to pay for this course.

Students with IELTS 5.5 (min 5.0) may change to 1+3 and take our 10-week Pre-Sessional English Language Programme (July to September). Please ask a teacher or email international.partners@lancaster.ac.uk for more information.
