Academic Criteria

Media and Cultural Studies / Sociology / Politics and International Relations

- 60% overall Gaokao / or 80% in Senior High 3
- 75% on SHISU-Lancaster 2+2 Programme

English Language Criteria

Course	IELTS	with EAP course (4 Wks)
All approved majors	6.5 (min 6.0)	6.0 (min 5.5)

4-Week English for Academic Purposes course (EAP)

This programme is compulsory for all 2+2 students. It is available to international students who have achieved the required IELTS score and for students who require an uplift of 0.5 points to achieve the requirement. The course focuses on English Language, study skills and general orientation. Students from GDUFS are not required to pay for this course.

Students with IELTS 5.5 (min 5.0) may change to 1+3 and take our 10-week Pre-Sessional English Language Programme (July to September). Please ask your teacher or email international.partners@lancaster.ac.uk for more information. The deadline is the end of May.

UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) regulations

Standard IELTS Academic is accepted for entry to Lancaster (including the EAP).

Students who apply to change to 1+3 and take the 10-week PELP would need to take UKVI IELTS Academic.
